

Institutional Distinctiveness

The vision of the institution is “Let the light of knowledge spread over all corners.” with this main objective the institution aims to develop human resources that would be useful for the nation and to provide opportunity for quality higher education to all in this backward tribal area. From the very beginning the college has been trying to spread the light of knowledge of different branches of higher education in this backward, tribal dominated remote area.

The most distinctive feature of our college is that, we have been imparting higher education to around 90% to 95% BPL students hailing from backwards ST, SC and OBC communities. Apart from admission in Major Courses, where minimum standard of marks secured in 10+2 level is insisted for selection, the admission in general courses is open to all class 12 pass candidates. They come from as far as 70 kilometers of radius. Due to poor economic conditions, they cannot stay in rented houses nor can they afford to stay in paying guest hostels. So, attending 75% of class in the whole year becomes a challenging job for them. as a result, imparting quality education to increasing number of students stands as a challenge to the college authority.
