The learned counsel submits that the provisions for selection and for publication of the select list are provided in Section 6 of the Assam College Employee (Provincialization) Act, 2005 and Rule 10 of the Assam Education Department Selection Rules, 1981.

In view of above, let notice of motion be issued, returnable by 4 (four) weeks.

Mr. S Das, learned counsel appears and accepts notice on behalf of respondent No. 1, while Mr. SR Rabha, learned counsel appears and accepts notice on behalf of respondent Nos. 2 and 3.

Petitioner to take steps for service of notice upon respondent Nos. 4 to 7 by registered post with A/D within 3 (three) days.

Petitioner to serve requisite extra copies of the writ petition to the learned counsels for the respondents.

List the matter again ***after 4 (four) weeks***.

In the interim, it is provided hereby that the respondent authorities concerned shall not make any appointment against the said post in question without first publishing the select list, as per law.

above named –

MOST RESPECTFULLY SHEWETH :

1. That the petitioner is a citizen of India by birth having permanent resident of the aforesaid locality and as such she is entitled to all the rights, protections and privileges guaranteed under the Constitution of India and any other relevant laws of the land.

2. That the petitioner is an educated unemployed. She has completed her HSLC examination in the year 1998 where results were pronounced on 10/07/1998 wherein she secured Second Division. She also completed her AHSEC examination in the year 2000 wherein also she secured Second Division and thereafter she pursued her B.A. under the Gauhati University from Tangla College with a major course in Assamese and she completed her Degree of Bachelor of Arts in the year 2003 wherein also she secured Second Class with 53.7% of marks and thereafter she

pursued her M.A. in Assamese (Group-B) from Gauhati University and completed the same in the year 2005 wherein she secured 59.6% mark in her M.A. examination in Assamese. It is needless to say that as Masters in Assamese so she knew Assamese well which is local language of State of Assam as well in BTAD area.

Photo copies of Certificates of H.S.L.C., A.H.S.E.C., B.A. and M.A, and Marksheet are annexed herewith and marked as Annexure Nos. 1, 2, 3 and 4 respectively.

3. That after completion of Master Degree the petitioner appeared in the examination of National Eligibility Test for Lecturership under the University Grands Commission in the year 2012 where the examination held on 24/06/2012 and the result of qualifying the NET was declared on 18/09/2012. On that effect the UGC issued an Certificate No. 121044457 in favour of the petitioner. In that Certificate it was also stated that the validity of the Electronic Certificate is forever.

A photo copy of NET qualifying Certificate is annexed herewith and marked as Annexure No.5.

4. That the petitioner states that the Deputy Commissioner of Darrang District issued a Certificate certifying that the petitioner is a permanent resident of Assam now the said locality is belongs to the BTAD area.

Photo copy of PRC is annexed herewith and marked as Annexure No.5A.

5. That after completion of M.A. examination the petitioner started teaching in various Colleges time to time and on that effect the Principal of Udalguri College, Udalguri, Principal, Harisinga College and Principal of Tangla College issued experience of teaching Certificate on various dates. Thereafter the petitioner has enrolled herself with the Gauhati University for pursuing her Ph.D. and she got her final registration for her Ph.D. for the topic of her research "Udalguri Zilar Sah Shramik Sakalar Katha Rup 'Sadini'; Ati Samaj Bhasha Boijnanik Adhyayan".

Photo copies of experience certificates and final registration letter for Ph.D. are annexed herewith and marked as Annexure Nos. 6 Series.

6. That the petitioner states that after completion of her Master Degree and after qualifying the NET examination and she stood eligible for Lecturership/Assistant Professor of

Degree College and accordingly she eagerly waiting for job/Assistant Professor under any Government College/provincialised College, Assam and accordingly she searching for advertisement. In that situation the petitioner came to know that the respondent No.6 issued an advertisement under the caption "SITUATION VACANT" on 20/08/2019 whereby the applications were invited for filling up some posts of Assistant Professors, among those posts one post for Assamese under the category of unreserved having specialization in LANGUAGE (B-Group) and the said notification was also sent to the Editor, The Assam Tribune, Guwahati, Assam for publication of advertisement for the posts of Assistant Professors and the said notification was published in the Assam Tribune of its issue dated 21/08/2019. In the said notification it was also stated that the candidates must have permanent residential certificate and must know the local languages. It is also stated that the preference would be given to the candidates who are the residents of BTC area subject to the fulfilment of all criteria. After getting that information regarding the advertisement under the caption "SITUATION VACANT" she get relaxed that finally she could able to apply for the Assamese post of Assistant Professor as she fulfil the eligibility criteria for the post. As per Annexure No.5A document petitioner is entitled to get preferential treatment for the post of Assistant Professor of Assamese Subject.

A photo copy of the advertisement dated 20/08/2019 is annexed herewith and marked as Annexure No.7.

7. That thereafter the petitioner applied for the post of Assistant Professor of Assamese (B –Group) annexing all the required documents within the stipulated period of time and after a long period the respondent No.6 issued an Interview Call letter dated 18/05/2022 whereby the petitioner was directed to appear before the penal of experts/interview Board on 2/6/22 form 10.00 A.M. onwards. In the said interview call letter no venue was mentioned. However the petitioner met the Principal of the College on the fixed date and time and Principal said that the penal of experts/interview Board would conduct the interview at the College itself, and accordingly the petitioner appeared before the penal experts/interview Board and she was interviewed by the same authority where she performed well and expecting for appointment for the said post.

A photo copy of call letter dated 18/05/2022 is annexed herewith and marked as Annexure No.8.

8. That the petitioner states that she got information from reliable source that she is the only local resident of BTAD and entitled to get preferential treatment.

9. That the petitioner states that as she appeared in the interview so a right accrued to her to know the result of the interview. As stated above interview was conducted on 2/6/22 for the said post but till date no result is published. Hence this Writ Petition is filed as there is inordinate delay to publish the result of interview.

10. That the petitioner states that due to delay in publishing the result the petitioner is in apprehending that somebody may be appointed in the said post of Assistant Professor of Assamese subject 'B-Group'. Hence it is bonafidely required to direct the respondents not to fill up the said post till disposal of the writ petition, otherwise this writ petition shall become infructuous if some one else is appointed in the said post during the pendency of this writ petition. For interim relief the balance of convenience is tilted in favour of the petitioner because she is the only candidate to get preferential treatment.

11. That the petitioner submits that non-publication of the result by the respondents in general and respondent No.5 in particular is arbitrary and unfair as such they have violated Article 14 of the Constitution of India.

12. That the petitioner submits that non-publication of the result by the respondents in general and respondent No.5

in particular is violated the natural justice, good administration fair play and good consciences.

13. That the petitioner submits that non-publication of result of interview create an apprehension in the mind of the petitioner that the petitioner would be discremenated by the respondents by violating Article 16 of the Constitution of India.

14. That the petitioner submits that she demanded justice which is denied to her by the respondents. Hence this Writ Petition.

15. That the petitioner states that she has no any other alternative efficacious remedy and remedy sought for herein is just adequate and complete under Article 226 of the Constitution of India.

16. That this application is made bonafide for the interest of justice.

Under the above facts and circumstances, it is therefore prayed that Your Lordships would be pleased to admit this petition, call for the

records, issue a Rule calling upon the respondents to show cause as to why a writ of Mandamus shall not be issued directing the respondents in general and respondent No.5 in particular to publish the select list of Assistant Professor of Assamese Department of Tangla College on the basis of advertisement 21/8/19 under No.CD/SV/P/SP002137/1 dtd. 21/8/2019 and interview held on 02.06.2022 and on perusal of records, reply to show cause if any and after hearing the parties would be pleased to make the rule absolute by directing the respondents in general and respondent No.5 in particular to publish the select list of Assistant Professor of Assamese department of Tangla College on the basis of said advertisement and interview. And/or pass any other appropriate order(s)/direction as your Lordship may deem fit and proper for the interest of justice.

Further it is prayed that till disposal of this writ petition the respondents may be directed not to fill up the post of Assistant Professor, Assamese (Group-B) of Tangla College advertised vide advertisement dtd. 21.8.2019 (Annexure-7).

And for this act of kindness the petitioner as in duty bound shall ever pray.
